REPORT ON PSYCHOSOCIAL ASPECT OF SENIOR CITIZENS DURING PANDEMIC

The International Nursing webinar series-IV – Titled "Psychosocial aspect of senior citizens during pandemic" organized by Department of Mental Health Nursing, Vinayaka Mission's college of Nursing, on 02.07.2020 at 2 pm to 3.30 pm.

The aim of the programme was to create awareness on the psychosocial problems among elderly people, during this pandemic period and measures to overcome the issues with suitable psychosocial interventions.

The programme started sharp at 2 pm. Mrs.AYEE, the HOD of department of MHN, welcomed the gathering and unfolded the theme. She introduced the resource person, Mr. Swamyvel sethuraman.

Honourable Orater **MR.
