The aim of the programme was to clearly orient about the challenges facing due to COVID 19 and its preparedness to the health professionals.

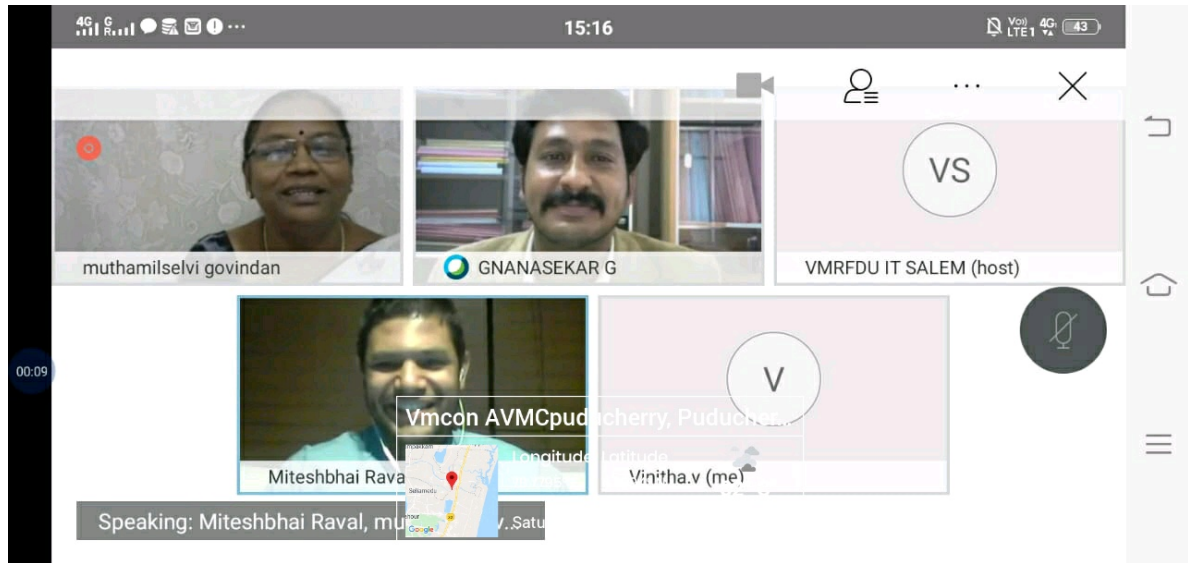

The session was highly informative which helps the nursing professional to update the state of knowledge. The participants were clarified their doubts at the end of the session.



