The medical camp began with the self introduction of medical team members. Health check-up was started at 9.30 am. Doctors from General Medicine and Optometry examined the old age people. On examination out of 13 old age people, 5 were diabetic, 4 were hypertensive and remaining 4 with ortho problems. According to their diagnosis, physiotherapy and medications were given Three of them were referred to AVMC&H for further investigation and management Followed that Mr. Radhakrishnan, Nursing tutor, VMCON, delivered the Health Talk on "Mental well-being". A total of 13 old age people have actively participated and got benefitted. Two faculties and 1 M.Sc Nursing student were involved in this camp.
