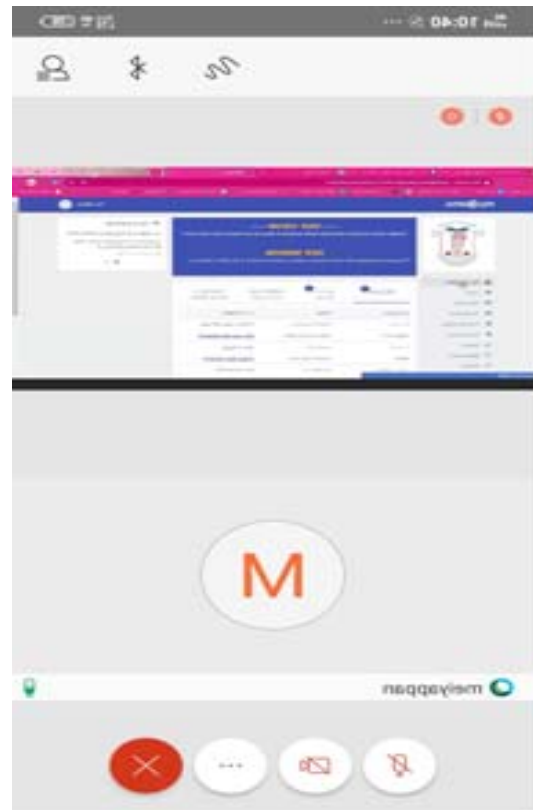
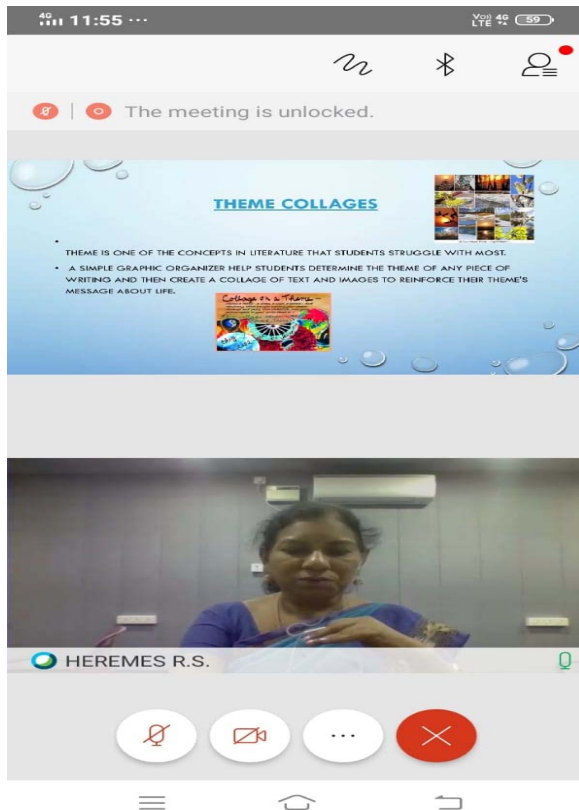
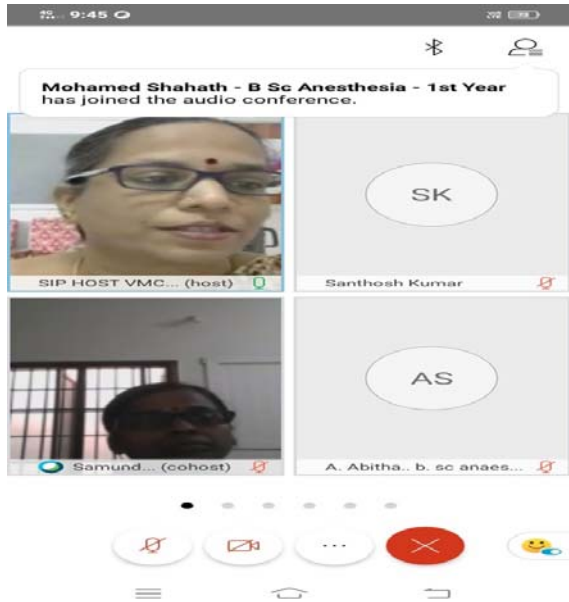
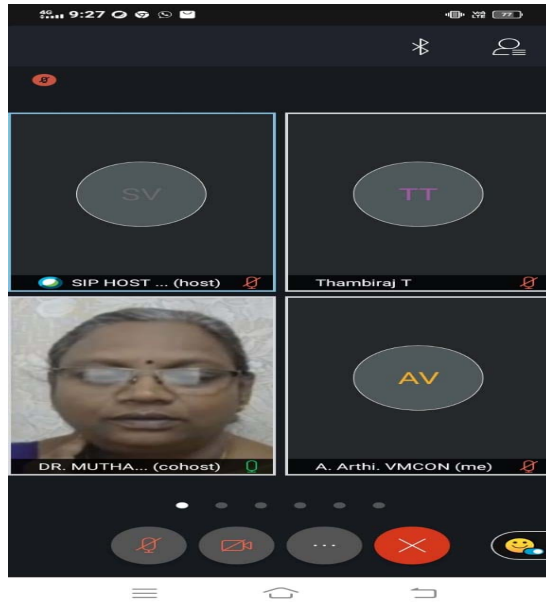
REPORT ON STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME – 16.12.2020
