REPORT ON STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME – 19.12.2020

Vinayaka Mission's College of Nursing, Puducherry organized the 12th day of Student Induction Programme about "Awareness on Pandemic Praxis and New Normal" on 19.12.2020. The programme was started at 9.30am.


The first session was started by Dr. Sankar Kalairajan, Professor, General Medicine, AVMC& H on "Early Identification & Control of new infections". In this session, he explained about the scenario of COVID-19 in India, the importance of early detection of infectious diseases, various investigations available to diagnose COVID-19, how to categorize the patients and available treatment modalities for COVID-19. He also explained the strategies to identify COVID-19 early & control of new cases. The session was completed at 10.15am.

The second session was handled by Dr. Nishanthini, Assistant professor, Community Medicine & Nodal officer – COVID 19, AVMC on "Outbreak management including Quarantine, Isolation, Contact tracing" at 10.15am. In this session, she elaborated about isolation and quarantine, criteria for quarantine, the difference between isolation & quarantine, criteria for assessing close contact & management of it. The session was ended at 10.50am.

The third session was handled by Dr. Anand Babu, Assistant professor, EVS, Community Medicine, AVMC on "Environmental Health and Sanitation" at 10.50am. In this session he explained about the importance of environmental health, dimensions of environmental sanitation, how to make the environment safer, ways to protect self & others from getting sick, Biomedical waste management in COVID 19, measures to be followed in COVID 19 pandemic to prevent infection transmission. The session was ended at 11.05am.

The fourth session was handled by Dr. Deepa, OG & DMS, AVMC& H on "Self Behaviors in New normal – What is Expected from Students?" at 11.15am. In this session she explained about the meaning of new normal, the challenges experienced by the students, teaching faculties & healthcare professionals and also about the safe behaviors during the unlock phase and the roles & responsibilities of the students in new normal period. The session was ended at 11.45am.

The final session was handled by Dr. N. D. Rajan, Deputy Director, AVMC on "SOP for Reopening" at 11.45am. He explained about the UGC guidelines regarding Examinations, Academic calendar and reopening of the colleges and also the issues & challenges faced by the institutions and the safety measures to be taken by the institutions before reopening and so on. The session was ended at 12.40pm. Totally 70 students were participated in this programme.



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
