DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH NURSING & IQAC REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL e-CONFERENCE - 23.4.2021 & 24.4.2021 Complementary and Alternative Medicine (Cam) In Mental Health

Day 1(23.4,2021)

The Department of Mental Health Nursing(MHN) in collaboration with IQAC, Vinayaka Mission's College of Nursing, organized an International e- Conference on "Complementary and Alternative Medicine(CAM) in Mental Health" from 23.04.2021 to 24.04.2021. The programme started with the welcome address by Mrs. Ayee, A HOD cum Associate Professor, Department of MHN, VMCON. Dr.G.Muthamilselvi, Principal, VMCON delivered the Presidential Address followed by Unfolding the theme by Mrs. Ayee. A.

The first session was handled by Dr. Ananda Balayogi Bhavanani, Director, CYTER, SBV University, Puducherry on the topic of "Yoga in Mental Health". He explained about the history, 8 limbs of yoga, & benefits of yoga. He demonstrated the few yoga techniques for eye strain, back ache, shoulder pain, stress reduction and relaxation.

The second session was dealt by Dr. Balamurugan.G Registrar (Admin), M.S. Ramaiah Institute of Nursing Education and Research Bangalore, on "Biofeedback mechanism & Chiropractic Medicine". He explained role of the nervous system plays in the mental health disorders and the use of Chiropractic Medicine in the treatment of mental ailments.

The third session was delivered by Dr. Haripriya. S, Associate Professor, Dept. of Food Science & Technology on "Diet & Nutrition". She explained about the importance of Gut-Biota in the synthesis and regularization of neurotransmitters. She also elaborated the mechanism of each neurotransmitters and its role in mental illness.

The fourth session was presented by Dr. Rajinikanth Maruthu, Clinical Nurse Manager, Bloom Field Mental Services, Dublin, Ireland on the topic of "Ayurveda". He described the history, common forms of medications in Ayurveda and its role in mental illness.

The last session of the day was shared by Dr. Mufeeth Khan, Chief Executive Officer, Alsaqar Healthcare Management, Hyderabad on "Accupressure & Accupuncture". He explained about the various

techniques that helps in dealing with mental disorders. He also demonstrated various accupressure massages to relieve vomiting, headache, stress, tension etc.,

The participants were actively involved and got clarified with their doubts from the experts at the end of every session. She explained about the VIBGYOR and its impact in mental health. She showed the methods to do chromatized water and the dosage used for various mental disorders.

The third session was presented by Mrs.Arul Jothi, V Associate Professor, Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, School & College of Nursing, Uttar Pradesh on the topic of "Siddha and Reiki therapy". She explained about the hilarious works of Siddhars and their contribution towards Mental health. She has also mentioned the Mental illness that was existed in Vedic period.

The fourth session was delivered by Ms. Nirmala. G, Faculty College of Health Sciences and Sports, University of Bahrain, Kingdom of Bahrain on the topic of "Qigong, Taichi & Laughter therapy" She demonstrated various Qigong and Taichi exercises to relieve stress, anxiety, depression & aggression etc., She also explained about the history, techniques and benefits of Laughter therapy.
