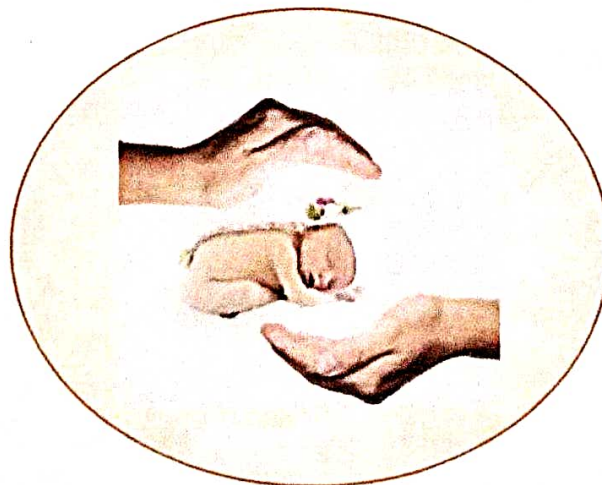

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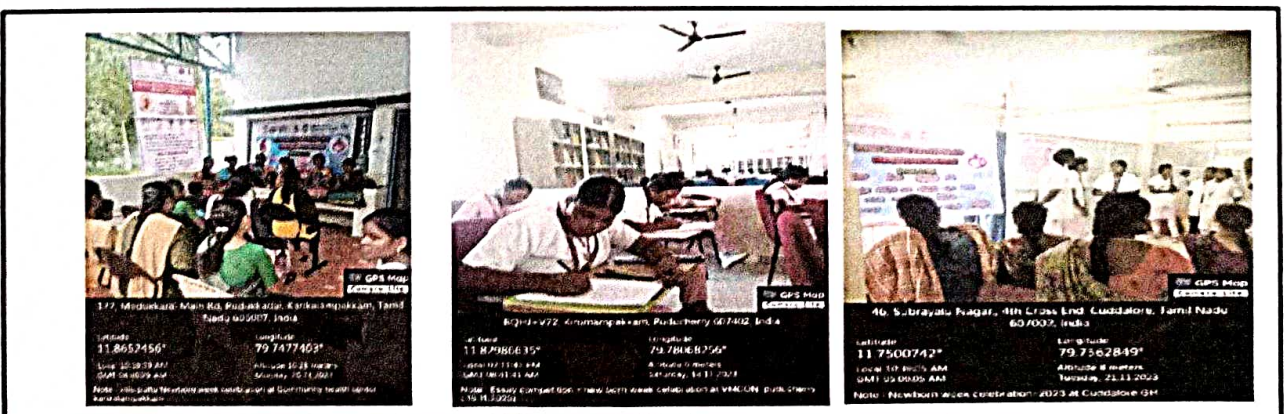

The Midwifery are actively participated and created awareness through the Health Talk – Birth Rights on 16.11.2023 at CHC, Karikkalampakkam, and Awareness Programme.
