OUTCOME BASED CURRICULUM IN NURSING: A QUALITY INITIATIVE

As a quality initiative measure, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of VMCON, Puducherry organized a workshop on “**Outcome based curriculum in Nursing: A Quality Initiative**” on 18th October 2019 at Lecture Hall, VMCON Puducherry. The guest trainer was Dr. Maragatham, M.Phil(N), Ph.D (N), Professor & HOD, Sri Bharani College of Nursing, Salem.

The workshop was stated at 9.30am with welcome by Dr. V.Sasi, IQAC coordinator. Followed with Dr. Maragatham took up the session those benefited by their workshop.

Description:

The faculty members were divided into five groups with 5-6 members in each group. The goal was focused towards creating the supportive learning environments for the student to achieve outcome based education.

She highlighted the benefits of OBE, its types and the importance of having them in the curriculum. She also explained the process map of OBE and the means to achieve it.

In addition to it, she also explained the revised bloom's taxonomy and its significant role in measurable objectives towards outcome based education. After the theatrical concepts explanation, the groups were given with task to e outcome of course outcome for III year B.sc

1. Framing programme outcome and course outcome
2. Framing QP for a subject in III year B.sc Nursing
3. Develop clinical outcome for students in Pediatric nursing clinical experience
4. Construct leaning outcome for the theory subject in III year B.sc (N)
5. Framing evaluation strategies for the students in III year B.sc (N)

Each group were given with 45 Minutes to work on with the task and presented it for the trainer's suggestion. All faculty gained awareness about the significance of PO, CO, CLO, etc. in outcome based nursing curriculum and versioned to follow the same to achieve better outcomes in profession.
